Record number of attendees, exhibitors, and art posted for sale

Confirmed art sales again exceeded \$1,000,000

Newly launched Hall I for Indie Creators at our [IC3](#) show

11th CAL dates set for May 17-18, 2025

Orlando, FL - November 23, 2024 - ComicArtFans.com (CAF), the global hub for everything related to collecting comic book and other narrative or storytelling art, announced today the successful production of its 10th [Comic Art LIVE](#) (CAL) virtual art convention on November 16 to 17, as well as dates for the 11th CAL and 12th CAL, which will be held May 17-18, 2025 and November 15-16, 2025, respectively.

CAL is a twice annual (May/November) virtual art convention that invites comic art collectors and fans from anywhere in the world to attend a free two-day virtual comic art convention where artworks are presented for sale directly from collectors, artists, art dealers, artist representatives, and auction houses. CAL also includes our hugely popular [Mystery Sketch](#) event, a unique and fun opportunity to get convention sketches with artists randomly assigned from a list of emerging and established talent who draw your single character of choice on roughly 9x12" art board, as well as two days of incredible live panels and art sale shows on our [CAL YouTube channel](#) where you can ask questions to panelists, interact with the collecting community, and purchase art in the live chat.

Professional artists are invited to set up a free exhibitor booth at CAL. Art collectors with a **CAF Premium subscription** (\$75/year) receive a large number of benefits, including being able to set up an exhibitor booth twice a year at CAL.

"With our 10th Comic Art LIVE successfully completed, we'll appraise what worked well, what can be improved or added, and start working on enhancements for our two shows in 2025," said Bill Cox, Chief Creative Officer of CAF. "After 22 years in business, CAF understands the needs of the art collecting community, and we will continue to align CAL with those things which strengthen this industry. It's also very important to us that CAF premium memberships continue to provide tools and features that assist every kind of art collector to discover, buy, and sell artworks in an efficient, reliable, and secure process. You can expect to see additional benefits for CAF Premium members added in 2025."

Highlights for the 10th Comic Art LIVE included:

- * **Checkout/Feedback System** - our new system for instant payment processing and the interlinked feedback system had expanded use with no issues and will be rolled out as an option to all exhibitors for the 11th CAL in May
- * **Technical upgrades/issues** - new HOLD function worked perfectly throughout the show; CAF log in glitches during CAL were resolved in support of verified checkout/feedback system use

"We're continuing to build out CAL to serve as an important show for the entire comic art community and as a primary, low barrier way for us to reach and create new comic and narrative art collectors," said Kasra Ghanbari, CEO of CAF. "CAL will now be actively developed to include better real-time functionality with communication, buyer/seller verification, and checkout options. Our team will also be aggressively expanding CAL to include more exhibiting artists and exclusive art, such as with our launch of Hall I dedicated to indie creators, with our goal being to have no less than 100 fantastic and diverse indie artists exhibiting in Hall I at CAL by this time next year."
