The 2nd Annual IC3-New Haven show was held on March 15, 2025 and featured more than 170 exhibitors including Dean Haspiel, Jim Rugg, Tom Scioli, Mike Marts, Ken Landgraf, Heather Antos, Ed Piskor Legacy, and Mahdi Khene. "CAF is quickly building out IC3 as a portfolio of both in-person and virtual shows committed to providing an affordable, dynamic, and inclusive platform that brings together independent comic book creators, artists, publishers, art collectors, and fans to celebrate and support unique and diverse creators in comics. IC3's current list of events is anchored by our annual IC3-New Haven show, which is held at Southern Connecticut State University, as well as two virtual IC3 shows as part of CAF's [Comic Art LIVE \(CAL\)](#) virtual art con held twice annually in May and November. All artists that exhibited at IC3-New Haven will be invited to set up a free exhibitor booth at our 11th CAL on May 17-18, 2025 where they'll be able to post both art and printed materials for sale, as well as offer art commissions.



Key numbers from our IC3-New Haven 2025 show included:

- * total event space more than doubled
- * attendance increased by greater than 50%
- * number of exhibitors increased from approximately 100 to 175
- * Pre-show artist commissions were actively promoted with a fantastic response from the art collecting community
- * Events expanded to include a Mini-Comic Competition and Scavenger Hunt with prizes

* IC3-specific sketch cards were introduced to go along with special oversized sketch cards as part of both the pre-show Drink & Draw and after-show parties

* "Panels That Matter" was introduced by IC3 Program Director Jamie Jones, with excellent attendance and participation; the panels are available for viewing on our IC3 YouTube channel [HERE](#)
